Assignment:

- Insect: Choose an insect and do several drawing studies of it on a page.
 Mediums: watercolor, pen and ink, and collaged paper. (use all mediums)
- 2. Song: Write your favorite lyric from a song. Repeat it over and over, on the entire page and illustrate it. Use the following mediums.

Mediums: pen/ink, ebony, pastel (use all three)

Due: Monday, February 12, 2018 (Ten points per class period late)

Grading: Each category is worth 10 points on each assignment. Total 50 pts. for each assignment.

- 1. Media: Was the correct media used?
- 2. Objective: How successful was the objective?

- 3. Creativity: Did you think outside the box?
- 4. Presentation: Did it look like it was well thought out and took time?
- 5. Skill: Was the finished product well executed and show good art skills.
