Formal Concert Etiquette

The Winter Fine Arts concert is a formal concert. Our students have worked very hard to get ready for this performance. Please follow these guidelines to make the performance enjoyable for everyone.

- 1) TURN OFF or SILENCE all cell phones and devices.
Please keep cell phones put away during the performance unless you are taking a picture/video. Be sure to enjoy most of the concert in person, not through the tiny screen of your phone 😊
- 2) Remain seated throughout the entire performance. It is distracting and disrespectful to the performers on stage for people to be coming and going. Only enter and exit between concert sections.
- 3) Do not talk or whisper while students are performing.
- 4) Keep small children seated and quiet during the performance. Take children outside if they become a distraction to others.

5) Show your heartfelt appreciation for the students' performance with applause at the conclusion of each song. **Please refrain from yelling, whistling, or calling out.**
