The PNMS Choir is a fun, hard-working, award-winning performance group and we take a great deal of pride in who we are and what we can do together.

Please read through this handbook with your child and complete and return both sides of the back page by August 26.

CLASS OBJECTIVES

- 1. Learn to sing as a group
- 2. Learn to read music
- 3. Learn to be part of a team as a member of a musical ensemble

GRADING POLICIES

1. Rehearsal Grades

The majority of your grade will be determined by your effort in class rehearsals.

- * You must have your music binder, pencil, and highlighter for every rehearsal
- * Breaking choir rules will result in a lower rehearsal grade

2. Written Assignments

There will be a few written assignments throughout the year.

3. Individual/Small Group Tests

Periodically there will be singing tests given in class. These tests help measure how well the individual student is doing on reading music. Again, these tests are important, but they do not carry as much weight as rehearsal grades.

4. Concerts, Events & Extra Rehearsals

Because our performances and extra rehearsals are considered "curricular" (they are a part of the educational scope of choir) they are **graded**.

If you have an <u>excused absence</u> from a concert or performance (parent sends a note), Mrs. Escamilla will allow you to make up the grade for partial credit.

An <u>unexcused absence</u> from a concert or performance will result in a failing grade for that event. If there happens to be a conflict between a choir performance and another school sponsored event, the conflict will be handled between Mrs. E and the sponsor. Missing a concert because of a non-school event (such as dance recitals, city league athletics, etc) will be considered unexcused.

*Please let your extra-curricular sponsors know our required performance dates NOW so they can schedule games and rehearsals to avoid conflicts.

CONCERT ATTIRE

Standard, informal choir uniform for concerts:

Choir T-Shirt (students must purchase one) worn with dress code compliant bottoms Winter Concert – nice holiday colored clothes (no shorts)

UIL Concert & SR Choir members will wear black and white, dressy to perform at UIL

DISCIPLINE

Behavior is very important in choir. Disruptive behavior can seriously affect our ability to succeed. Behavior problems will be addressed one on one with the student first. If improvement is not made, there are a number of avenues that can be pursued depending on the circumstances. These include a phone conversation or conference with a parent, demerits, office referrals, or in extreme situations, removal from choir. If you are unable to have self discipline during rehearsal, choir is not the best elective for you.

Discipline standards apply whenever the choir travels as well. All PNMS rules and policies are to be observed even when we are not on campus. Everywhere we travel we represent our school and community. We want to leave positive impressions wherever we go!

Students with discipline issues (referrals, ISS, time spent at alternative campus) may not be allowed to attend choir concerts or trips. You may be placed on probation.

END OF YEAR TRIPS

These are the requirements for attending the trip with the choir:

- Perform at Winter Concert and Spring Concert, Pecan Festival (7th/8th Grade)
- Maintain Satisfactory Conduct in all classes
- One "extra" event per trip 7th/8th Grade:All-Region Day Camp, All-Region Audition, or Solo & Ensemble; 6th Grade: Pecan Festival or Solo & Ensemble

MATERIALS NEEDED FOR CHOIR (Due by Friday, August 26)

- 3 ring binder, folder, or similar to keep in the choir room (any color)
- Pencil pouch and 2 pencils and 2 different color highlighter (to be kept in binder)
- Parent and student sign up for Remind
- Turn in completed back page of this handbook

PNMS Choir Rules

1: BE PREPARED FOR EVERY REHEARSAL

- * Gather all necessary materials and be seated before the tardy bell rings
- *Get water and use the restroom before class (you may have a water bottle at your seat)
- *Take care of contacting parents before school or during Study Hall

2: TREAT EVERYONE WITH RESPECT

- * Treat others as you would have them treat you
- * Do not interfere with someone else's learning
- * Leave negative attitudes and comments elsewhere
- * Avoid any behavior that may embarrass the reputation of our choral program
- * Maintain appropriate teacher-student demeanor at all times. Even though we know each other well, appropriate boundaries must remain

3: PARTICIPATE WITH ENTHUSIASM

- * Sing with energy, good singing posture, appropriate vowels and an activated face
- * Eliminate behavior that interferes with our progress as a group
- * Use choir time to learn about music, not for homework in other classes

4: LIMIT TALKING

- * Talking in rehearsal is frustrating to those around you
- * Talking makes it difficult for us to improve
- * Limit communication to only what is absolutely necessary
- * Personal conversations must happen outside of class

5: NO GUM, CANDY, FOOD, DRINK, OR PHONES

- * Food & drink in the choir room is not allowed (water is okay)
- * No distracting items in the room during school hours
- *Cell phones must be put away in your backpack during rehearsal
- *Smart watches are for time only, not texting

PNMS Choir Procedures

Entering the room: Place your belongings in the designated area. Get your supplies and come directly to your assigned seat.

Supplies: Have necessary supplies every day. Music will be checked for required rehearsal markings.

Tardy: Any student not in their assigned seat when the bell rings will be considered tardy. If you are tardy, go quickly and quietly to your seat.

Questions: If you would like to ask a question or make a relevant comment, raise your hand and wait to be called on. Do not speak during instruction or while others are talking. Think first before you interrupt rehearsal for something that can wait.

Leaving your seat: If you need to leave your seat, raise your hand and wait to be called on. Do not interrupt the rehearsal unless it is an emergency.

Restroom/Water/Personal Business: Take care of these things before school or between classes, not during rehearsal. You have two restroom/water trips per 6 weeks.

Classroom Language: Use appropriate language in the classroom. If you can't say something nice, don't say anything at all. Do not express a negative opinion of choir music - it will often grow on you as you continue to learn it

Attitude: Enter the choir room with a positive attitude. Do not allow personal problems to interfere with rehearsal. Maintain a friendly demeanor in class.

Equipment and Supplies: Only use shared classroom supplies. Do not borrow Mrs. E's supplies. Musical equipment (piano, mics, sound system) is very expensive and delicate. Do not use or touch without permission.

Nurse Visits: Covid-19 Protocol limits nurse visits to true emergencies. Band-Aids and similar First Aid supplies are available in the choir room.
