

Your child will be sent to me in case of illness or accidents and for various health screening activities. For the protection of all students, PN-GISD follows the guidelines and standards outlines by the Texas Department of Health, Texas Education Agency, and local School Board Policies.

If your child is experiencing illness before school, he/she should be kept home for observation. There are limited facilities for putting your child to bed at school and this can be done only temporarily.

Please complete the entire Emergency Card Form. A child will not be sent home unless you or the emergency contact person listed is contacted. For extreme emergency medical attention, you will be notified as soon as possible. It is important to list three reliable contact people to pick up your child or permit their release from school in the event you cannot be reached.

IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT EMERGENCY CONTACT NUMBERS ARE CURRENT AND ACCURATE.

If your child has a health condition listed on the emergency form, please contact the school nurse as soon as possible.

The following health screenings are conducted annually. Parents will be notified of any unusual findings.

Screening Activities	Scheduled Time
Height & Weight	Biannually (Fall & Spring) for Grades PreK-8
Vision	Annually for Grades PreK-8 First time Entrants to District Referred Students
Hearing	Annually for Grades PreK-8 First time Entrants to District Referred Students
