Cherry on Top— Students may earn in several ways; may earn multiple performance acknowledgement.

- Dual Credit Course—12 hours; 80 or higher
- Bilingualism & Biliteracy—LOTE 3 years 80 or higher
- AP Test—earn 4 or 5
- PSAT, PLAN, SAT, ACT (Scores vary by exam)
- Earning a business or industry certifications or license

Whipped Cream— Distinguished Achievement

Nearly every endorsement requires Algebra II. To earn distinguished achievement students must complete Algebra II & an endorsement. Must earn distinguished achievement to be eligible for the 10% automatic admission rule.

Toppings—Endorsements

Every students will choose at least one. (You may earn more as high school progresses). Endorsements available:

- Arts & Humanities
- Business & Industry
 - STEM
- Public Service
- Multidisciplinary

Students must earn at least 4 additional credits to earn an endorsement: 1 additional math, 1 additional science, and additional/electives credits in that area. For a total of 26

Ice Cream - The foundation of every high school diploma:
